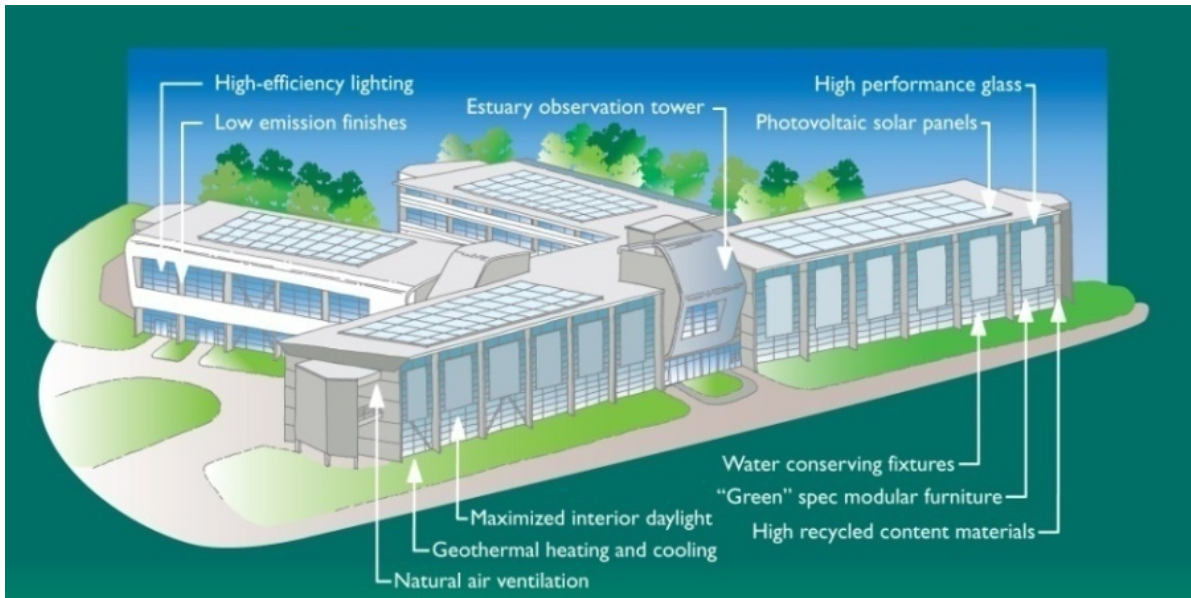


ABOUT THE OHLONE COLLEGE NEWARK CENTER



The Ohlone College Newark Center is the “Greenest College in the World!”

The Ohlone College Newark Center for Health Sciences and Technology opened in January 2008 with an enrollment of over 3200 students. The building encompasses 135,000 square feet on an 81 acre site. Tour participants will view many of the elements that gave the campus its LEED Platinum certification—the highest level possible in green building standards.

Highlights:

- *1585 solar panels that generate up to 50% of the building's energy needs*
- *26 miles of geothermal ground coils*
- *Two 10-foot diameter enthalpy wheels, fresh-air energy recapture systems that save up to 25% of costs for cooling and heating*
- *Water efficient, Bay Friendly® landscaping*
- *Ground denim insulation, more efficient than traditional fiberglass*
- *“Machiche” Guatemalan hardwood, responsibly harvested using Forest Stewardship Council guidelines*
- *Brownfield remediation of pesticide contaminated soil*
- *Wetland restoration site to become Living Laboratory for campus, and more*
